The governing body of the City of Justin proposes to use revenue attributable to the tax rate increase for the purpose of new Patrol Vehicles for the police department. The City Council will vote on the proposed tax rate and the FY 2016-2017 budget on September 26, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, Justin City Hall, 415 North College Avenue, Justin, Texas.
