City Secretary, Brittany Andrews, certified that no other candidates filed for the one (1) year unexpired City Council position for the May 6, 2017, Special Election.

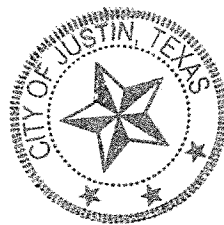

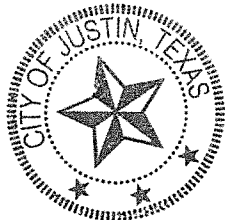

ORDINANCE 022-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JUSTIN, TEXAS, DECLARING UNOPPOSED THE CANDIDATE FOR AN UNEXPIRED ONE YEAR TERM ON CITY COUNCIL ELECTED TO OFFICE; CANCELLING SPECIAL ELECTION ONLY; REQUIRING ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION TO THE CANDIDATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a special election was called for May 6, 2017, to elect a Council member to fill an unexpired term of one year; and

WHEREAS, no proposition appears on the ballot and the City Secretary has certified that there is only one candidate for the unexpired one year term for Council and that, therefore, such candidate is unopposed for office; and

WHEREAS, no candidate's name has been placed on a list of write-in candidates for any office under applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has delivered such certification to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JUSTIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the above stated premises are true and correct.

SECTION 2. That the unopposed candidate for the unexpired one year term on the City Council, Lynn Crites, is hereby declared elected for a term of one year, ending in May, 2018.

SECTION 3. The City Secretary is directed to issue a Certificate of Election to Lynn Crites in the manner and at the same time as provided for a candidate elected to office at the election. Each person elected must qualify for the office in the manner provided by the Texas Constitution.

SECTION 4. The May 6, 2017 Special Municipal Election for the one year unexpired term for City Council is cancelled and the City Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this ordinance to be posted on Election Day at each polling place used or that would have been used in the election. Provided however that this ordinance shall have no effect on the General Municipal Election on May 6, 2017, for the offices of Mayor and two Council members to serve two year terms each, ending in May, 2019.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, as the law in such cases provides.
