Justin City Council Meeting -March 12, 2018

The Justin City Council Meeting convened into a Workshop Session being open to the public the 12th day of March, 2018 at 5:00 pm in the Council Chambers of Justin Municipal Complex, and notice of said meeting giving the time, place, date and subject there of having been posted as prescribed by Article 5 of the Texas Government Code, with the following members present and in attendance to wit:

WORKSHOP SESSION

1. Discuss Ordinance 638-18 regarding Landscape and Buffer Requirements.

Councilman Woodall -asked Councilman Crites if anyone from his neighborhood has had the chance to look through this? Helen Eades with Pacheco Koch- we have made good progress, and feel this is great representation of Justin. Councilman Mounce – is this good enough for our City? He does not agree that everything should be grandfathered.

2. Discuss a potential amendment to the Justin Fee Schedule regarding miscellaneous building permit fees.

City Manager, Cori Reaume went over the tables, and the changes between option 1 & 2. Councilman Woodall – I personally like option 2, it sounds very reasonable.

3. Discuss Pool Ordinance 639-18.

City Manager, Cori Reaume – this has been brought back to you again, and after further research, we feel this is a good representation of what you would want to have in place.

4. Discuss creation of an Impact Fee Committee.

City Manager, Cori Reaume – Staff recommendation is that the current Planning and Zoning Commission also act as the Impact Fee Committee.

5. Discuss parking concerns in residential areas due to increased commercial traffic.

Councilman Woodall – Look at Justin Seed, and the parking lot next to the bank to see if the Mule Barn overflow can possibly park there. Councilman Mounce – Would like to see if the Police Department can check the decibels, and increase the patrol in that area.
