FALL CLEANUP EVENT

THE CITY OF JUSTIN WILL HOST A FALL CLEANUP EVENT ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5TH, 2019 FROM 8:00AM TO 12:00PM.

Residents of Justin can bring their bulk trash to City Hall during that time for disposal at no cost. The roll-off dumpsters are available until they are at capacity, so plan to arrive early.

Proof of residency in Justin City limits will be required via driver's license or water bill. This Cleanup Event will include bulk trash, electronic waste/recycling, and document shredding. Please note that tire disposal **will not** be offered at this event.

Disposal of the following items are free of charge. E-waste includes:

- Cell phones
- Laptops (with or without hard drive)
- Computer towers (with or without hard drive)
- Monitors, keyboards, and mice
- Power cords and speakers

Additional \$20 Disposal/Processing Fee for each item:

- TV's up to 65" (no large screen projections models)
- CRT computer monitors
- Microwaves (no commercial models)
- Desktop printers (no commercial models)

Additional \$10.00 for Processing/Disposal fee each item:

- Hard Drive Shredding (on site). Hard drive must be removed from computer prior to arrival.

Paper shredding includes all sensitive documents such as:

- Banking info, checks, statements, records
- Payroll information
- Financial statements
- Insurance information

No need to remove paper clips, staples, file folders, or rubber bands...we can shred those!
