Fall Cleanup Event

The City of Justin will hold our Annual Cleanup Event on Saturday, October 27th, 2018 from 8:00am to 12:00pm. Residents of Justin can bring their bulk trash to City Hall during that time for disposal at no cost. The roll-off dumpsters are available until they are at capacity, so be sure and plan to arrive early.

Proof of residency in Justin City limits will be required via driver's license or water bill for:

- Bulk waste drop-off
- Household hazardous waste
- Electronic waste/Recycling

We will also have **tire disposal available**. The tire disposal is available to both residents and nonresidents.

The Crud Cruiser will be available from 9:00am-11:00am to take your household hazardous waste such as paint, batteries, and automotive fluids. We will also have Electronic Waste Recycling and Paper Shredding available.

E-waste includes:

- Cell phones
- Laptops (with or without hard drive)

- Computer Towers (with or without hard drive)
- Monitors, Keyboards, and Mice
- Power Cords and Speakers
- Desktop Printers and Scanners

Additional \$20 Disposal/Processing Fee for each item:

- TV's up to 65"
- CRT Computer Monitors
- Hard Drive Destruction (off site)-For a certificate of destruction

Paper shredding includes all sensitive documents such as:

- Banking info, checks, statements, records
- Payroll information
- Financial statements
- Insurance information

No need to remove paper clips, staples, file folders, or rubber bands...we can shred those!
